Professor Wang Xiaodong

Director and Investigator, National Institute of Biological Sciences, Beijing

Dr. Xiaodong Wang is a member of the US National Academy of Sciences and a foreign member of the Chinese Academy of Sciences. He graduated from Beijing Normal University in 1984 and received his Ph.D. Degree in Biochemistry from University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center in 1991. He is currently Director and Investigator of Beijing's National Institute of Biological Sciences and Chair Professor of Tsinghua Institute of Multidisciplinary Biomedical Research. Since 1995, Dr. Wang's research has mainly dedicated to the study of programmed cell death. Defects in programmed cell death are a key step in the development of cancer, auto-immune diseases and degenerative diseases. Dr. Wang has been awarded many accolades, including the Shaw Prize in Life Science and Medicine, the Qiu Shi Outstanding Scientist Award, and King Faisal Prize in Science.
